Grade 10 - THINKING SKILLS

Tests problem solving and critical thinking.

Grade 11 - IeBT

Mathematics and Physical Sciences benchmarking to prepare students for entry into tertiary studies.

Grade 12 - National Senior Certificate (NSC)

Students write a minimum of seven subjects - four core and three elective.

With the introduction of the iPad to the College in 2013, Woodlands has continued to improve on the technological offering available to our students – in 2018 Woodlands secured a 150mb fibre line into the College and every classroom and learning space has been equipped with a commercial-quality wi-fi backbone.

Further, the ongoing roll-out of mobile devices throughout the College will continue to move forward so as to not only enhance the technological capability of every teacher and student at Woodlands, but also to ensure that 21st Century skills are developed to levels that will allow our students to move confidently into the world beyond Matric as highly capable global citizens.
